SESSION 1

Olivia Bina, Instituto de Ciências Sociais da Universidade de Lisboa

Olivia Bina is Research Fellow at the Institute of Social Sciences at the University of Lisbon and Adjunct Assistant Professor in the Department of Geography and Resource Management of the Chinese University of Hong Kong (CUHK). She is also a Member of the International Institute of Asian Studies (IIAS). Her first degree is in Political Science from the Università Statale di Milano (1991, Italy). She holds an MPhil in Environment and Development from the University of Cambridge (1993, United Kingdom) and a PhD in Geography (2004) also from the University of Cambridge.

Andrea Ricci, Istituto di Studi per l'Integrazione dei Sistemi (ISIS)

ISIS Vice President, Andrea joined ISIS in 1981. He received his engineering degree at Ecole Centrale (Paris, France) in 1977. His key qualifications include: sustainability policy analysis and impact assessment, forward-looking analysis, energy studies and information systems, and transport studies and information systems. He has participated in and coordinated many EU RTD projects, including EFONET (FP7), NEEDS (FP6), FLAGSHIP, PASHMINA, and URBACHINA.

Domenico Rossetti di Valdalbero, DG RTD, European Commission

Domenico Rossetti di Valdalbero is responsible for managing a large part of the Socio-economic Sciences and Humanities themes of the 7th EU Research Framework Programme (FP7). He is currently coordinating and implementing the Horizon 2020 Societal Challenge on “Inclusive, innovative and reflective societies”. Domenico specialised in the following topics: new paths of economic growth, global Europe, socio-ecological transition and smart urban futures.

Carlo Sessa, Institute of Studies for the Integration of Systems (ISIS)

Before joining ISIS in 1983, Carlo Sessa conducted research at New York University, where he worked with Nobel Prize winner Wassily Leontieff. He has coordinated several EU research projects, in the 5th, 6th and 7th Framework Programmes, mostly in the fields of transport, environment and urban governance issues. Carlo is currently a leading researcher involved in the FP7 Social Sciences and Humanities projects PASHMINA, GLOBAL-IQ and MEDPRO – Prospective analysis for the Mediterranean region.

Andreu Ulied, MCRIT

Since 1994, Andreu Ulied has been a Partner Director of MCRIT. He has worked as consultant in most European countries, as well in North Africa, China, India, Latin America and the Caribbean on urban and regional planning issues for city councils and large infrastructure-related companies, as well as for international institutions such as United Nations Habitat, World Bank and the Inter-American Development Bank.

Fabiana Scapolo, Joint Research Centre, European Commission

Fabiana Scapolo has been working at the European Commission, Directorate General Joint Research Centre (JRC), since 1999. She is located at the JRC Headquarters in Brussels where she is part of the Science Advice to Policy Unit. She is a team-leader on Foresight and Horizon scanning activities of the JRC. Currently, she is leading a Foresight study on the future of standards and standardisation as a tool to facilitate innovation and competitiveness. She is also involved in Foresight studies on healthy food and diet; food security and the future of eco-industries.

SESSION 2

Paul Zagame, Seureco

Paul Zagame is a professor at the Université Paris 1 Panthéon-Sorbonne. He was a Chairman of the Economics Section of the National Council of Universities. He is currently the scientific director of the laboratory ERASME research team. The team specialises in the field of economic modelling applied to the analysis of structural economic policies, particularly those related to energy and the environment, and research and development. He also contributed to numerous European projects in the areas of economic modelling and technical progress, environment, energy and land use.

Baptiste Boitier, Seureco

Baptiste Boitier joined the SEURECO team in 2005. His research focuses on economic modelling and policy impact assessment (taxation, mitigation policy, energy, land use, etc.). He is also responsible, inter alia, for the scientific monitoring of the FP7 European project NEUJOBS, FLAGSHIP and AMPERE. He has also participated in the WIOD, PLUREL and DEMETER EU projects.

Daniel Vitry, Paris II University

Daniel Vitry has been a professor Emeritus at Paris II University since 1979. He is a Doctor of Economic Sciences, specialising in Portfolio Management. From 1986 to 1988, he served as technical advisor to Alain Devaquet, Minister of State for Higher Education and Research. In 2005, he was appointed Deputy Director of cabinet of François Goulard, Minister for Higher Education. Daniel Vitry is the author of several books in economics, including *Evaluation of Capital* (1972), and *The role of taxation in business growth* (1973).

Iñaki Arto, Basque Centre for Climate Change (BC3)

Iñaki Arto is a research fellow at BC3. He has occupied research positions at the Joint Research Centre of the European Commission (2010-2013) and the University of the Basque Country (2001-2010). His research focuses on environmental-economic modelling (Integrated Assessment, Computable General Equilibrium, Dynamic Econometric Input-Output), Input-Output analysis and social metabolism. He has contributed to several books and has published articles in international journals, such as *Ecological Economics*, *Environmental Science and Technology* and *Journal of Industrial Ecology*.

Werner Bosmans, European Commission, DG Environment

Werner Bosmans graduated as a bio-engineer at the University of Ghent, Belgium. He acquired a PhD in International Economics from École Nationale Supérieure d'Architecture Montpellier. In 2005, he joined the Directorate-General Environment of the European Commission, where he is now responsible for the implementation of the Thematic Strategy on the Sustainable Use of Natural Resources, promoting life-cycle thinking to reduce environmental impacts.

SESSION 3

Stavros Zouridis, The Hague Institute for the Internationalisation of Law (HiIL)

Stavros Zouridis is connected to Tilburg University as Professor of Public Administration. At Tilburg his research focused primarily on the interplay of law, public organisation and informatisation. Currently, he combines his prime function as professor in Public Administration with an advisory role at WagenaarHoes Organisatie advies. His research focuses on the impact of the rule of law on public decision-making, public organisation, and the actions of administrators, regulators, prosecutors and judges.

Norberto Andrade, The Hague Institute for the Internationalisation of Law (HiIL)

Norberto Nuno Gomes de Andrade (PhD in Law, European University Institute, Florence – Italy) is a Scientific Officer in the Information Society Unit of the European Commission's Institute for Prospective Technological Studies — a part of the Joint Research Centre. His research interests centre on law and technology, namely on electronic identity, identity management systems, data protection, privacy, telecommunications law, Internet governance and the regulation of cyberspace.

Pierre-Alain Schieb, Organisation for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD)

Pierre-Alain Schieb is Counsellor in the Advisory Unit to the Secretary-General of the OECD, which manages the International Futures Programme. He is in charge of the International Futures Network and is Head of OECD Futures Projects, such as the ongoing project on Global Infrastructure Needs (Prospects and Implications for Public and Private Actors), the project on Risk Management Policies in Selected OECD Countries and the project on the BioEconomy in 2030.

Rudolf A. Müller, former Scientific Counsellor in the SECO (Bern), former Delegate of the Swiss government in OECD IFP activities

Throughout his career, Rudolf A. Müller obtained a thorough training in public affairs and administration, international organisations, economic associations, industrial relations, politics, (multilateral) diplomacy and research. He worked as chief statistician, chief economist, executive board member, speaker, editor, head of delegation and head of project, in the vast domain of economic policy. He had also practised in adjacent fields, such as public finance, labour market, education, migration, innovation, technology, industry and social policy. Since 2007, Müller has been assisting business persons in economic and legal matters.

Kai Böhme, Spatial Foresight GmbH

Kai Böhme is the Director of Spatial Foresight GmbH. He specialises in European regional and territorial research and policies, international comparative studies in the fields of regional development policies, spatial planning, and in the territorial impacts of sector policies. He has a truly European background and considerable experience in policy advice at the European and national level, as well as in the management of international applied research and consultancy projects.

Christian Lürer, Spatial Foresight GmbH

Christian Lürer is a junior consultant at Spatial Foresight GmbH. He joined the team in 2011 after studying economic geography and urban, regional and transport planning at the RWTH Aachen. He had also studied geography and public law at the WWU Münster in Germany. At Spatial Foresight, Christian contributes to various projects for ESPON, DG REGIO, BBSR (Bundesamt für Bau-, Stadt- und Raumforschung), as well as different INTERREG programmes.

Eduarda Marques da Costa, Institute of Geography and Spatial Planning, University of Lisbon

Eduarda Marques da Costa is Associate Professor at the Institute of Geography and Spatial Planning of the University of Lisbon. She has taught Geography and Spatial Planning since 1990, and has been a researcher at the Centre of Geographical Studies since 1987. Her main scientific areas of interest are Regional, Urban and Local Planning, Urban Geography and Evaluation of Public Policies. Since 1988, she has worked as a consultant in private and public institutions coordinating different research projects.

Enrico Giovannini, University of Rome Tor Vergata and former Minister of Italy

Enrico giovannini is a Professor of Economic Statistics at University of Rome Tor Vergata, Senior Fellow at the LUISS School of European Political Economy and Visiting Fellow at the European Commission's European Political Strategy Centre. He is also a member of the Club of Rome think tank and a board member of various Italian and international foundations and organisations. The United Nations Secretary-General recently appointed him to co-chair the Independent Expert Advisory Board on Data Revolution for Sustainable Development.

Thiemo W. Eser, Luxembourg Ministry of Interior and Territorial Development

Thiemo W. Eser studied economics, as well as regional, urban and environmental economics and holds a doctorate in economics from the University of Trier, Germany. He was senior lecturer at the faculty of economic and social sciences of the same university for several years. He has published and led various projects financed by the EU in Western and Central European countries. The projects concerned the topics of European integration, regional policy and evaluation, federalism and governance, spatial and sustainable development.

Anil Markandya, Basque Centre for Climate Protection (BC3)

Professor Markandya graduated from the London School of Economics as a Master of Science in Econometrics and was awarded his PhD on the Economics of the Environment. Since then, he has divided his time between academic and advisory work. On the academic side, he has published widely in the areas of climate change, environmental valuation, environmental policy, energy and environment, green accounting, macroeconomics and trade. He has held academic positions at the universities of Princeton, Berkeley and Harvard in the US and at University College London and Bath University in the UK.

Anette Braun, VDI Technologiezentrum GmbH, FLAGSHIP Scientific Advisory Board

Anette Braun is a Senior Consultant at VDI Technologiezentrum, conducting socio-economic analysis of global trends, in particular in the areas of health, medical and biotechnology, the analysis and synthesis of results on health and biotechnology issues, as well as their links with political strategies. She is a member of European Commission's High Level Expert Groups "Key Technologies for Europe 2020" and "Global Europe 2050". She is also a member of the Scientific Advisory Board (SAB) of the EU Flagship Forward-Looking Driving Change.
